EXPERIENCE SUMMARY:

October 1997 – Present

March 2008 – Present: Patrol Sergeant. In addition to supervising patrol officers, conducts performance evaluations and discipline as necessary. Auxiliary duties include Quartermaster, working within a budget, purchasing uniforms, and equipment for the department, ordering of medical supplies, maintaining AED compliance in coordination with vendor service contract. Assists with the planning, coordination and supervision of Town wide special events such as the Memorial Day Parade. Conducts multiple required school safety drills for five Avon Public Schools, in accordance with state statute. Has received training in de-escalation and uses this on a regular basis.

September 2007 – March 2008: Detective Sergeant. Supervising detectives with in-depth investigations, crime evidence processing, liaison with outside State, local, and Federal agencies, oversees confidential information; supervises the court liaison officer and the Juvenile Detective in sensitive investigations, and works within a division budget. Supervised and conducted background investigations of police officer and dispatcher candidates.

June 2006 – September 2007: Administrative Sergeant, managing and supervising the Records and Training Divisions. Ensuring arrest paperwork is prepared for court, assigning court issued subpoena requests to officers, requests for documentation in accordance with Freedom of Information laws. Coordinates recertification for all sworn personnel, training certifications for Communications Dispatchers, training for civilian personnel, additional training requests, working within a training budget. Maintaining the daily and weekly scheduling of all officers and dispatchers, and other civilian personnel; processing requests for officers to work private duty from outside companies (i.e., public utilities).

November 2003 – June 2006: Promoted to Sergeant and assigned to the Patrol Division. Supervising patrol officers; ensuring policies and procedures are followed; understanding of Connecticut General Statutes; ensuring proper staffing levels; and reviewing all Officers' paperwork, such as incident reports, arrest paperwork, and motor vehicle infractions.
